<b>Object / No Objection:</b>	Object
<b>Request additional information:</b>	A detailed groundwater model constructed for the operation is required before the viability of the proposed activity could be considered. An economic benefit analysis should be conducted which deals with the cost of remediation of the environmental damages as well as the loss to the agricultural sector.
<b>Concerns:</b>	The Verlorenvlei which is an important ecological hotspot both nationally and internationally is under threat by climate change as well as agricultural expansion. As such the future survival of the lake has been a focus for many water scientists in the region. The proposed mining of tungsten in the Krom Antonies, which by weighted average is the largest contributor of freshwater to the lake, further jeopardises critical baseflow required to maintain lake water levels. While the proposed mining activity does not use a considerable amount of water, the dewatering required for open pit mining will result in changes in natural groundwater flow. While the mining could bring economic benefit to the region, the reduced availability of groundwater could reduce agricultural productivity which has to be weighed up against the environmental concerns and the loss to the agricultural sector.

Your concerns are noted and will be included in the final Scoping Report, and assessed in the Environmental Impact Assessment Report that will be distributed for public commenting. Your concerns will also be forwarded to the hydrologist, geohydrologists and socio-economic specialist that forms part of the project team, for them to assess as part of their studies.

At present, we can confirm that project related water will not be extracted from the Verlorenvlei. As stated in the draft Scoping Report, the Applicant intends to transport the process water to the mining area from an offsite reverse osmosis plant, instead of making use of the potable water in the Valley. Details in this regard will be included in the Environmental Impact Assessment report (EIAR) that will follow in due time.
