Golden valley poultry farm is in process of applying for the rectification in terms of Section 24G of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended, for the unlawful establishment and continuation of the poultry facility on a Portion of the Golden Valley Poultry Farm, Doornkuil 78, Welkom RD, Free State Province. Greenmined Environmental (Pty) Ltd was appointed, as the Independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP), responsible for the facilitation of the rectification application.

SITE DESCRIPTION

Golden Valley Poultry Farm is located on a portion of the farm Doornkuil 78, situated in the Magisterial District of Lejweleputswa in the Free State Province. 


Figure 1: Locality Map of the site.

- Granting Golden Valley Poultry Farm rectification in terms of Section 24(G) 24(F0 and 12(3) of the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998, as amended).
- Granting authorisation to Golden Valley Poultry Farm form complying with the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, as amended:
 - R 386, Listing Notice 1 of 21 April 2006 Activity 1(h)
 - R544, Listing Notice 1 of 2 August 2010 Activity 5

The development and related operation of facilities or infrastructure for the concentration of -

- I. More than 1000 poultry per facility situated within an urban area, excluding chicks younger than 20days;
- *II.* More than 5000 poultry per facility situated outside an urban area, excluding chicks younger than 20 days
- III. More than 5000 chicks younger than 20 days per facility situated within an urban area; or
- IV. More than 25 000 chicks younger than 20 days per facility situated outside an urban area.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The activity that was illegally commenced with entails the development and operation of chicken layer houses for the purposes of commercial production. The waste streams comprise of poultry litter generated by Golden Valley Poultry Farm, as well as a low percentage of organic matter from the layers houses and its facilities.

The illegal activities commenced with in 2014. The activities that have already been completed includes:

- 6 Chicken houses 80m long x9m wide x 2.5-3m high,
- Housing of 9000 chickens per house (density are in accordance to by-laws);
- Total of between 35 000 and 36 000 chickens on the property;

Equipment installed in the chicken houses includes:

- Chicken cages;
- Drinking system;
- Feeding system;
- Manure handling system; and
- Climate control system.

Activities still to be completed:

A sixth chicken layer house.
