PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proposed mining site will be an extension of the existing quarry pit previously distributed by stone aggregate mining activities. The mining methods will make use of blasting means of explosives in order to loosen the hard rock, the material is then loaded and hauled out of the excavation to the mobile crushing and screening plants. The aggregate will be stockpiles and transported to clients via trucks and trailers. All activities will be contained within the boundaries of the site.

The proposed mining area is approximately 25.4 ha in extent and the applicant, Inzalo Crushing and Aggregates (Pty) Ltd, intents to win material from the area for at least 20 years. The aggregate / stone gravel to be removed from the quarry will be used for road construction in the vicinity. The proposed quarry will therefore contribute to the upgrading / maintenance of road infrastructure in and around the Kroonstad / Parys area.

The mining activities will consist out of the following:

- Stripping and stockpiling of topsoil;
- Blasting;
- Excavating;
- Crushing;
- Stockpiling and transporting;
- Sloping and landscaping upon closure of the site; and
- Replacing the topsoil and vegetation the disturbed area.

The mining site will contain the following:

- Drilling equipment;
- Excavating equipment;
- Earth moving equipment; and
- Mobile crushing and screening plants.

DUST:

- Speed on the access road will be limited to 30 km/h to prevent the generation of excess dust.
- Roads will be sprayed with water or an environmentally friendly dust-allaying agent that contains no PCB's (e.g. DAS products) if dust is generated above acceptable limits.
- All disturbed or exposed areas will be re-vegetated as soon as possible during mining to prevent any dust source from being created.
- Water from the existing pit will be pumped out of the quarry and reused for mineral processing and dust suppression.

NOISE:

- It will be ensured that employees and staff conduct themselves in an acceptable manner while on site.
- All mining vehicles will be equipped with silencers and maintained in a road worthy condition in terms of the Road Transport Act.
- The noise generated form the mining machinery will be similar to noise generated along the N1 by public vehicles. Blasting noise will be instantaneous and of short duration. This will only occur once every two to three weeks
- The type, duration and timing of the blasting procedures will be planned with due cognisance of other land users and structures in the vicinity.
- Surrounding land owners will be notified in writing prior to blasting occasions.

ACCESS ROUTE:

- Informal roads already exist on site and no new roads will be constructed. Vehicular movement will be restricted to existing access routes to prevent crisscrossing of tracks through undisturbed areas.
- Should any other access roads to the mining area be required it will be established in consultation with the landowner however existing roads will be used as far as practicable.

SURFACE AND GROUND WATER:

The proposed activities are not expected to have a negative impact on any surface and ground water of the area.

VEGETATION:

Undulating plains supporting short grassland, in natural condition dominated by Themeda triandra while Eragrostis curvula and E. chloromelas become dominant in degraded habitats. Dwarf karoo bushes establish in severely degraded clayey bottomlands. Overgrazed and trampled low-lying areas with heavy clayey soils are prone to Acacia karroo encroachment.

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BACKGROUND INFORMATION DOCUMENT

GEOLOGY & SOILS:

Sedimentary mudstones and sandstone mainly of the Adelaide Subgroup (Beaufort Group, Karoo Supergroup) as well as those of the Ecca Group (Karoo Supergroup) found in the extreme northern section of this grassland, giving rise to vertic, melanic and red soils (typical forms are Arcadia, Bonheim, Kroonstad, Valsrivier and Rensburg)-typical of Dc land type (dominating the landscape). The less common intrusive dolerites of the Jurassic Karoo Dolerite Suite support dry clayey soils typical of the Ea land type.

CLIMATE:

According to SA Explorer, the area normally receives about 467mm of rain per year, with most rainfall occurring mainly during mid summer. The chart below (lower left) shows the average rainfall values for the area per month. It receives the lowest rainfall (0mm) in July and the highest (85mm) in January. The monthly distribution of average daily maximum temperatures (centre chart below) shows that the average midday temperatures for the area range from 17℃ in June to 28℃ in January. The region is the coldest during June when the mercury drops to 0℃ on average during the night. Consult the chart below (lower right) for an indication of the monthly variation of average minimum daily temperatures.




Figure 1:Average rainfall for the area




Figure 3: Average night-time temperature




Figure 2:Average midday temperature

SENSITIVE LANDSCAPES:

- No sensitive landscapes under statutory protection occur on the site.
- There are no protected areas (game parks/ nature reserves or monument) in close proximity to the proposed site.

SITES OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL AND CULTURAL INTEREST:

No sites of archaeological or cultural importance were identified during the site inspection as the site has been extensively used for mining and sugar cane farming purposes.

FAUNA:

- No animals where spotted during the site inspection. Animals that may occur in the area will be very similar to those found around Koppies. The area was previously disturbed for the recovery of gravel. Small mammals, reptiles and insects will occur in the area.
- The fauna at the site will not be impacted by the proposed mining activity as they will be able to move away or through the site, without being harmed. Workers should be educated and managed to ensure that no fauna at the site is harmed.

VISUAL EXPOSURE:

- The mining area was identified to constitute the lowest possible visual impact on the surrounding environment.
 The surrounding area has previously been disturbed by mining activities, and this application entails the extension of the existing mining area.
- The site will be visible from the N1.
- The applicant should however ensure that housekeeping is managed to standard, as this will mitigate the visual impacts during the operational phase of the mine.
- Upon closure the site will be rehabilitated and sloped to insure that the visual impact on the aesthetic value of the area is kept to a minimum.
- ▶ The site will have a neat appearance and be kept in good condition at all times.

ABLUTION, WASTE WATER & WASTE DISPOSAL:

- Ablution facilities will consist of chemical toilets hired from a contractor and serviced regularly.
- Any effluents containing oil, grease or other industrial substances will be collected in a suitable receptacle and removed from the site, either for resale or for appropriate disposal at a recognised facility.

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

For the re-establishment of a quarry on the farm Bloemhol no. 14 situated in the Parys Magisterial District.

Mr. Jacob Petrus Coetzee (*Owner*) hereby give permission to Inzalo Crushing and Aggregates (Pty) Ltd. (*Contractor*) to extend the existing quarry on his farm for the purposes of constructing, tar roads in the Parys and Koppies region under the following conditions:

- 1. The quarry will be extended on the southern side towards the N1 National Road.
- 2. The area used during the construction period will be completely fenced off with a suitable stock proof fence. On completion of operations the quarry (the existing quarry as well as new additions thereto) will again be fenced off in a similar manner as present. The temporary stock proof fence will then be removed. An access gate for the Owner, similar to the existing gate, will again be placed in the fence and the Contractor will see that the Owner has access to the water level by vehicle as discussed.

In addition:

The Contractor will see that there is no trespassing by his employees onto the property of the Owner. Such employees will also not be entitled to utilize any amenities of the Owner. The Contractor indemnifies the Owner for any damages in this regard.

The Contractor shall undertake all the activities referred to in this agreement and all costs in this regard shall be borne and paid by the Contractor.

3. The area will only be used for the purposes of crushing and stockpilling of aggregates. The asphalt plant will not be erected on the property.

Access to the quarry will only be through the existing access to the existing quarry.

- 4. In addition to its other responsibilities/duties as herein set out and as laid down by law, the Contractor shall at all times:
 - 4.1 be cognizant of the fact that the property is used by the Owner for purposes of farming and bass fishing;
- 4.2 exercise its rights expeditiously and in such manner as to cause the minimum disturbance to the activities of the Owner;
 - 4.3 as far as possible comply with nature conservation principles;
- 4.4 be responsible for the conduct of its representatives, employees or invitees, and indemnifies the owner in respect of any damages arising from the conduct of any such representatives, employees or invitees;
 - 4.5 take whatever reasonable steps as may be necessary to secure the safety and well-being of the animals and people on the property. All costs incurred in this connection shall be borne and paid by the Contractor;
 - 4.6 ensure that the Property is restored to a condition which is, according to the EMP, conducive to the safety and well-being the animals and people on the property:
 - 4.7 clean up all areas attended an and remove all waste matter including wiring and rubble after completion of the agreement, should their operations cause stones/rocks to fall outside the quarry area, such stones/rocks shall also be removed by the Contractor at his costs after completion of the contract.

- A royalty of R5.00 (Five Rand) exclusive of VAT, for each ton sold by the Contractor will be paid to the Owner for the rights to the land and tone. All amounts will exclude VAT. The actual quantity of material sold will be weighed over a weighbridge and the totals given to the Owner monthly in arrears. The Owner will then submit a Tax Invoice from a registered VAT vendor for payment within 7 (Seven) days.
- 6. The Contractor will pay compensation to the Owner in the amount of R70 000,00 (Seventy Thousand Rand) plus VAT to restock the quarry with fish at the end of the contract period. Payment of this amount shall be effected within 7 days after the Contractor having completed his crushing operations.

Upon payment of the amount set out herein, the Contractor will be exonerated of all liability regarding the handling and replacement of any fish that may reside in the water of the quarry.

- 7. This agreement will run concurrent with the Mining Licence/Mining Right. Once our project has been secured, a program may be agreed. The intent is to target projects in the area as they become available.
- 8. The access road from Parys Greenlands (R723) turn-off to the quarry must be maintained during the whole operation of the quarry as well as during the period when material is being drawn from it. As per the attached sketch, Eskom's network is affected, however Distribution (Dx) will raise no objection to the proposed works, as long as you adhere to Eskom's conditions and treat the powerlines as live at all times.
