

NOTICE OF WATER USE APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given in terms of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998).
The applicant Inzalo Crushing and Aggregates (Pty) Ltd, submitted a water use licence application for mining within a 100m of a drainage line, destruction of a portion of a drainage line, stockpiling and dust suppression on Portion 0 (Remaining Extent) of the farm Thabazizwe No 16691, Kwazulu Natal Province.
