Reference is made to your report received by this office regarding the above-mentioned application. This office reviewed the report and does not have any objections to the proposed development on the Farm Sydenham on conditions that;

1. Environmental awareness posters must be made available by the ECO and be displayed on site. Environmental do's and Don'ts must be clearly illustrated. The posters must use picture to convey the intended message and any explanatory text must be in Sotho, English and Afrikaans.
2. Storm water management plan must be compiled to ensure that monitoring and rehabilitating of erosion events associated with the development. Appropriate erosion mitigation measures must form part of this plan to prevent and reduce the risk of any potential erosion.
3. All vehicle used for transportation and or construction purpose should remain within these demarcated route and area in order to limit unnecessary compaction of topsoil and to prevent disturbance of animals and plants outside of construction areas.
4. Measures should be put in place to protect the borrow pits from illegal dumping of waste.
