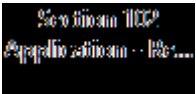

The following has been considered:

Tank maintenance

Figure 7 as it appears on page 20 of the DBAR indicates that the proposed tanks will be installed and managed in the same manner as the existing tanks at the site are managed. But, from the picture on the left it is so evident that the tanks need attention as there is an indication of oil spillages. A maintenance and or caution and management when using them is recommended. The Applicant is requested to conduct ongoing improvements on oil storage operations for all the tanks. The Applicant is requested to instal a secondary containment around the storage tanks and a constant maintenance thereof is advised.

Risks analysis

The Applicant is advised to thorough analyse all risks associated with the tank installation more-so the bund to adhere to the bund specifications as outline on page 28 of the DBAR to contain spillages and incidents that can emerge.

Environmental Authorisation

The Applicant is advised to consider including the following listed activity:

GNR 327 Listing Notice 1 Activity 51:

The expansion and related operation of facilities for the storage, or storage and handling, of a dangerous good, where the capacity of such storage facility will be expanded by more than 80 cubic metres.

The Applicant is further advised to note and adhere to the conditions as outlined in the Environmental Authorisation as issued in 2008 by the Department of Economic Development and Environmental Affairs with a reference number: EC06/386/7/07-104.

Waste management

The applicant is advised to carefully take due diligence in handling hazardous waste on-site and dispose thereof. The waste generated onsite needs to be disposed of at registered municipal landfill sites not at the dumping site as indicated in the DBAR. The applicant needs to dispose all general waste at a registered general landfill site and the hazardous waste to be disposed of at municipality registered hazardous waste landfill site.

The applicant is advised to adhere to the conditions of the waste licence to be issued as per the outcome of this application.

Greenmined acknowledge receipt of, and thank you for the comments submitted on the DBAR regarding the Section 102 amendment application by Makhanda Mining (Pty) Ltd over the Remaining Extent of the farm Brakkefontein No 243 in the Albany District of the Eastern Cape (reference number EC 30/5/1/2/2/0056 MR).

We incorporated your comments into the final Basic Assessment Report (FBAR) to be submitted to the DMRE for decision making, and responded as followed to your comments in the FBAR:

Tank Maintenance:

The use of a maintenance programme for the dangerous goods storage tanks was added to the mitigation measures proposed in this report. It must be noted that the spot perceived to be an oil spill (in Figure 7), was in fact dirt/debris that was broomed from the surrounding paved area. However, the comment is noted, and all the dangerous goods tanks will be installed in areas with secondary containment.

Risk Analysis:

A thorough risk analysis will be conducted before the installation of the proposed tanks on site, and the outcome of this analysis will be filed on site for auditing purposes.

Environmental Authorisation:

GNR 327 Listing Notice 1 Activity 51 was added to the application as suggested, and the adherence of the Applicant to the current EA issued by the DEDEAT was also added to the mitigation measures in this report.

Waste Management:

The DBAR was amended to stipulate the disposal of waste at a registered general/hazardous waste municipal landfill site.

Lungi Ngidi excited about Proteas' fast-bowling stocks

SA paceman welcomes fierce competition for starting spots in national team

Proteas bowler Lungi Ngidi is excited by the increasing fast-bowling stocks within the senior national team set-up, which has increased fierce competition among the players.

Ngidi, Kagiso Rabada and Anrich Nortjé are front-line fast bowlers, but Marco Jansen, Duanne Olivier, Lizaad Williams, Beuran Hendricks, Glenton Sturman, Lutho Sipamla, Sisanda Magala, Daryn Dupavillon and Junior Dala are waiting in the wings. All-rounders Wiaan Mulder, Dwaine Pretorius and Andile Phehlukwayo will also be fighting for starting spots in the squad in the coming international season.

"We are competing and you need to perform pretty much every game too," Ngidi, one of the many SA sports stars managed by the Roc Nation Sports International agency owned by American music and entertainment mogul Jay-Z, said.

"There is a guy waiting at the door and the minute you slip up he is ready to take your spot."

"We keep on competing and you should see how hectic it gets at training, especially when we know that selection is getting closer and closer."

"All of a sudden you see guys bowling faster and faster and really putting their best forward. It is always great for our

cricket to see competition among the guys and it is showing in the results."

Ngidi credited coach Mark Boucher for giving him a chance in the Test series against India last season after a long time in the wilderness, where he returned with 15 wickets in six innings.

"If I can look back to that first Test match against India, I think

coach Mark Boucher showed a lot of confidence in me by playing me with everyone knowing that I hadn't played cricket in a long time."

"For a coach to have faith in you like that and for me to be able to produce the results is exactly what I needed."

"If I hadn't played well in that game, I could easily have been replaced in the next Test."

"It comes to be that cut-throat but at the end of the

day, the only thing that you can ask for is an opportunity and that is what coach Boucher gave me for that Test match."

Since he made his Test debut against India in 2018, Ngidi has only played 13 matches.

"That all comes down to selection because you don't pick yourself."

"The other thing is that when I came in to play there were still Morne Morkel, Vernon Philander and Dale Steyn, and for the majority of the first

season I didn't really get games."

"With time moving on, there were a couple of injuries and we also don't play that many Test matches in a year."

"This year we are playing about eight and if I get to play all of those matches, I will catch up with almost four years of cricket."

"You can miss one series and that is almost half of the season, but if we happen to play more Test cricket I am hoping to increase those numbers."

"In ODIs, I have played over 30 matches, the numbers are growing and I wouldn't call myself a junior any more."

"I have played enough cricket to know what is required of me, even with those 13 Test matches I feel what I have to do now and what is required of me." — TimesLIVE

Caster Semenya gets her first international assignment at 5,000m

Caster Semenya has been included in the provisional team for the African championships in Mauritius in early June, but Wayne van Niekerk is the notable omission.

The 400m world record-holder, who withdrew from the SA championships in Cape Town last month because of a hamstring niggle, didn't compete during the qualifying window from January 1 to April 23.

Semenya will compete alongside Dominique Scott and Kyla Jacobs in the 5,000m, where she is still trying to obtain the 5 min 10.00 sec qualifying time for the world championships in Eugene, Oregon, before the June 26 deadline.

Van Niekerk, who also needs to qualify for the world event, was expected to start racing in Europe in late May or early June, his agent Peet van Zyl said.

The continental showpiece, which is scheduled to run from June 8 to 12, will be the first time that Semenya will compete for SA over 5,000m.

It is also her first international assignment since the 2018 Commonwealth Games, after which World Athletics introduced its new gender eligibility rules.

Semenya, the former two-time Olympic and three-time world 800m champion, is refusing to take testosterone-lowering medication to compete in distances from 400m to 1,500m and has taken her fight to the European Court of Human Rights.

The SA team of 74 features a range of veterans and youngsters, made up of 58 women and 36 men.

The only events in which there are no participants are the men's 5,000m, women's 3,000m steeplechase and women's triple jump.

Athletes have until Friday to appeal against their exclusion

or to argue why they shouldn't be in the team.

The final team must be submitted to the African body by the end of the week.

● **Disappointment at lack of recognition won't hinder future efforts, says captain**

Patel credits team effort for premier league triumph

Mechatronics Uitenhage have vowed to come back even stronger after they claimed their maiden Eastern Province Cricket premier league title.

Sadique Patel, who captains the Kariega-based side, was proud of his team's efforts and said that despite a lack of formal recognition from the provincial body for their achievement, it would not affect their approach to the new campaign.

Patel's men, despite a slow start, showed consistent form throughout the campaign, winning 18 of the 20 matches they played and losing just two.

They ended the 2021/2022 season with a total of 87 points, 14 more than second-placed Jendarmark United Cricket Club who ended on 73 points, having played the same number of matches.

Patel said there was a bit of disappointment due to the lack of recognition for their maiden title-winning exploits.

"The guys were a bit down after the season because we never got any recognition for our achievements, there was no announcement of who the official club champions actually were," he said.

"We only received a letter notifying us of the season ending and how many clubs had struggled to finish the season.

"There was no trophy hand-over or ceremony to crown us as champions, so that was a bit disappointing seeing as it is our first time winning the title.

"We just told ourselves that there is always next season, we know what it takes and we have the talent and skills to do it, so we just need to go out next season and prove ourselves again."

Patel said the pandemic had caused chaos for the cricketing

fraternity, and it was no different for his club.

"We've had just as many problems as many other clubs around the city, both financially and from a facilities point of view.

"We don't have water in Uitenhage, so our president had to run around looking for water for us to prepare our pitches, so all clubs have had problems, but we still went out there and gave our best each week," he said.

He commended his players' commitment to the cause, especially given all the issues they faced from a financial and facilities point of view.

"Due to vandalism, our pitches were destroyed and we had a half concrete pitch on which we practised," Patel said.

"I feel we achieved the goals we had set out at the start of the season. The guys were hungry to play the game, so from a motivational point it didn't need much work.

"There are quite a few youngsters in the team, myself being captain for the first season, so I feel like the senior guys deserve a lot of credit for how our season played out."

He said another element that galvanised their performances, especially in the second half of the season, was the addition of former Warriors batsman Eddie Moore.

"It was great to have him with us, he played about six or seven games with us, and as soon as he came into the team, we were already on a bit of a high, but he just added that extra level of experience and professionalism.

"We had been struggling with our top order but as soon as he came in, he just brought so much calmness to the batting line-up and our younger guys really looked up to him," Patel said.
