This application was rejected by the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) due to the existence of a dormant Mining Permit.

This application (10771 MP) was subsequently rejected by the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) due to the presence of another dormant mining permit on the same footprint. The dormant application was withdrawn, and a new mining permit application (NC 30/5/1/3/2/10799 MP) for environmental authorisation was submitted by VZS on 21 November 2019 that was accepted by the DMR on 20 January 2020.

GEMSBOK-KAKAMAS: Hoërskool Martin Oosthuizen op Kakamas vier vanjaar sy 100ste bestaansjaar. Die klein skool met die groot hart het oor die jare groot atletiekprestaties opgelewer. Tydens die jaarlikse kleureatletiek is 'n paar van die houters van die oudste rekords vereer.

Die oudste HMO-atletiekrekord staan vanaf 1974 agter die naam van Egbie Nel vir skyfwerp, S15 – 'n volle 44 meter.

Louise Meintjies wat in 1991 gematrikuleer het, hou ook 'n hele paar HMO-rekords: gewigstoot D.17 – 12,17 m (1990), skyfwerp D.17 – 37,02 m (1990), gewigstoot D.19 – 13,55 m (1991), skyfwerp D.19 – 40 m (1991).

Jaco Swart wat in 2002 gematrikuleer het, was tot 2019 die houer van ses HMO-naelloperrekords. Tans hou hy vier rekords: 300 m H S.15 – 44,7 sekondes (1999), 400 m H S.17 – 57, 5 sekondes (2001), 400 m H S.19 – 56,54 sekondes (2002), 400 m S.17 – 50,7 sekondes (2001).

Die volgende oudleerders kon die byeenkoms bywoon en mnr. André Mouton, die skoolhoof van HMO, het aan hulle sertifikate oorhandig.

Die oud-HMO'er wat die meeste rekords hou, is Christin Fox. 'n Volle nege. Haar indrukwekkende prentjie lyk só: 300 m H D.15 – 48,3 sekondes (2014), verspring D.15 – 5,24 m (2014), 90 m H D.15 – 13,9 sekondes (2014), 200 m D.15 – 27,1 sekondes (2014), 100 m D.15 – 12,8 sekondes (2014), 200 m D.17 27,63 sekondes (2015), 100 m H D.17 – 16,01 sekondes (2016), verspring D.19 – 12 m (2017), 100 m D.17 – 12,9 sekondes (2016), verspring D.19 – 5,12 m (2017).

Evander Kasimbingue, wat verlede jaar matriek geskryf het, hou vier rekords: 100 m S.17 – 11,0 sekondes (2018), 200 m S.17 – 23,0 sekondes (2018), 200 m S.19 – 22,6 sekondes (2019), 400 m S.19 – 50,1 (2019). Evander was in 2017 die vinnigste S.17- 400 m-atleet in Suid-Afrika.

Kyla Swiegers (matriek 2018) se driesprongrekord (D.19) staan vanaf 2018 – 9,01 meter. Drikus de Vos wat in 2009 gematrikuleer het, het in 2008 (S.19) 'n tyd van 17,2 sekondes in die 110 m H genaël. Suzaan du Raan (gebore Le Roux), Drikus se klasmaat, is vanaf 2006 die rekordhouer vir die 800 meter (D.15) 2:40,0 en in 2008 het sy die rekord vir D.17 400 m H – 78,0 sekondes – bygevoeg.

Lance Isaks (matriek 2008) is die S.15-hoogspringrekordhouer met 1,72 meter. Hy het dié rekord in 2005 opgestel. John Montsho wat in 2007 matriek geskryf het, is van daardie jaar af die rekordhouer van die 5000 m S.19 met 'n tyd van 18:59,6.

Jaco Conradie is die skyfwerprekordhouer vir S.17 vanaf 2001. Hy het 'n afstand van 44,55 meter behaal. In 1990 het Madelein Jordaan (gebore Malan) die rekord vir hoogspring D.15 op 1,51 m gestel. Dit staan nog.
