RE: NOTICE OF APPLICATION IN TERMS OF SECTION 102 OF THE MINERALS AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2002 (ACT NO 28 OF 2002) AND THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT 107 OF 1998 NEMA) AS WELL AS THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS, 2014 (AS AMENDED 2017).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Sand mining commenced in the 1980's on Portion 4 of the farm Zandberg fontein No 97, Robertson, with the Viljoen family mining the area from 1994. In 2018, the mining right was ceded from WJ Viljoen to Zandberg Sandput (Pty) Ltd that is the current mining right holder (hereinafter referred to as the "MR Holder"). The mining right is valid until 2047, with an approved footprint of 17.6826 ha. The Zandberg mining method entails strip mining that is representative of the small scale mining industry where the sand is loaded with one front-end-loader (FEL) directly onto the trucks of clients that transports it from site. Little to no stockpiling is required and no washing of sand is needed. The MR Holder removes the topsoil of a strip of ± 1 ha within which the sand is mined in blocks of approximately 50 x 50 m. Topsoil is replaced over every mined-out strip prior to the opening of the consecutive strip.

PROJECT PROPOSAL

The MR Holder intends submitting an application for consent of the minister to expand the existing mining right footprint of the Zandberg sand mine with 108.3851 ha, in terms of Section 102 of the MPRDA, 2002. The proposed expansion area will be developed over an area currently used for agricultural purposes. Should the S102 application be approved mining will progress into the expansion area as the current mining footprint is mined-out. The mining method will remain the same as the method currently implemented by the MR holder. No infrastructure will be established in the extension area.

SITE DESCRIPTION

The Zandberg sand mine is located ± 7 km south-west of the Robertson town. The extent of the proposed extension area is ± 108.39 ha, and the GPS coordinates of the area are as listed below.

LEGAL COMPLIANCE

The proposed Section 102 (MPRDA) amendment application triggers the following listed activities in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act 107 of 1998) and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014 (as amended 2017) and therefore requires an environmental impact assessment (EIA) (full EIA) that assess project specific environmental impacts and alternatives, consider public input, and propose mitigation measures, to ultimately culminate in an environmental management programme that informs the competent authority (Department of Mineral Resources) when considering the environmental authorisation:

■ GNR 324 Listing Notice 3 of 2017 Activity 12:

The clearance of an area of 300 square meters or more of indigenous vegetation.

i) *Western Cape Province*

- i) *Within any critically endangered or endangered ecosystem listed in terms of section 52 of the NEMBA or prior to the publication of such a list, within an area that has been identified as critically endangered in the National Spatial Biodiversity Assessment 2004;*

■ GNR 325 Listing Notice 2 of 2017 Activity 15:

The clearance of an area of 20 hectare or more of indigenous vegetation.

OTHER LEGISLATION TRIGGERED BY THE PROPOSED PROJECT:

- An application for the amendment of the mining right in terms of Section 102 of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (Act No 28 of 2002) will be submitted to the Department of Mineral Resources – Western Cape Province.
- A land development application will be submitted to the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning in terms of the Land Use Planning Act, 2014 (Act No 13 of 2014), as well as the Langeberg Local Municipality in terms of the Langeberg Municipality: Land Use Planning Bylaws, 2015 (No 264 of 2015).
- A notice of intend to develop will be submitted to Heritage Western Cape in terms of the National Heritage Resources Act, 1999 (Act No 25 of 1999).

BRIEF SITE DESCRIPTION

GEOLOGY AND SOIL:

The geology of the study area is known for its acidic lithosol soils derived from Ordovician sandstones of the Table Mountain Group, as well as recent aeolian sand accumulations of riverine origin (Breede River). The Viljoen family has been mining high quality building sand from the property since 1994.

HYDROLOGY:

The proposed expansion area falls within the Upper Breede Sub-Water Management Area which is managed as part of the Breede Water Management Area by the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS). There are no dams, rivers or wetlands in the proposed sand mining footprint, however it extends over an area classified as a phase 2 FEPA (Freshwater Priority Area) according to the National Wetlands and NFEPA map of SANBI. The conservation status of the area will be assessed and discussed during the EIA process of this application.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION DOCUMENT

FAUNA AND FLORA:

According to Mucina and Rutherford (2012) the expansion area extends over two vegetation type known as the Breede Sand Fynbos (FFd 8) and the North Sonderend Sandstone Fynbos (FFs 13). The Breede Sand Fynbos is listed as a vulnerable ecosystem, while the North Sonderend Sandstone Fynbos is classified as Least Threatened. According to the 2017 Western Cape Biodiversity Spatial Plan (as shown in the figure below), the Langeberg Critical Biodiversity Area 1 (CBA) extends across the earmarked area. An ecologist will be appointed to conduct a vegetation study of the proposed footprint area. This report will be available as part of the EIA documentation.



Figure 2: Image showing the presence of the Langeberg CBA 1 (green shading) in relation to the proposed expansion footprint (crossed polygon).

The fauna present within the boundaries of the property comprise of natural occurring small rodents, reptiles and various bird species. No protected or red data faunal species were identified within the earmarked footprint, and the project is expected to have a negligible impact in this regard.

LAND USE:

The project area is located in the Langeberg municipal area, with Robertson being the nearest town. Robertson is one of the largest wine-producing regions in RSA. The majority of the population reside in urban areas, as the agricultural sector is currently experiencing economic difficulties. As mentioned earlier, the land use of the earmarked property mainly comprises of grazing, mixed with small scale sand mining. A land use application will be submitted to change the current agricultural zoning of the proposed footprint to industrial.

AIR AND NOISE QUALITY:

The wind patterns in the Robertson area are highly influenced by seasonal variations. According to the wind statistics as presented on Windfinder.com the prevalent wind direction distribution is in a south to south-easterly direction from November to March. From April to October the wind mainly blows in a west-north-western direction. Due to the nature of the sand mining operation the dust levels are expected to be very low.

The ambient noise levels of the greater surrounding area is low, with the noise levels of the study area (immediate surroundings) impacted on by traffic along the bordering public road and various farming operations. Due to the small scale of the sand mining operation the cumulative impact on the noise levels of the receiving environment is expected to be negligible.

HERITAGE:

The proposed expansion area where selected over the sand dunes to the north-west of the current mining area. No known areas of heritage, archaeological and/or palaeontological importance were identified within the earmarked footprint. However, a Notice of Intend to Develop will be submitted to Heritage Western Cape for their perusal and commenting. If needed, an appropriately qualified specialist will be appointed to conduct a Heritage Impact Assessment of the study area.

FINAL REHABILITATION

The closure objectives are for progressive rehabilitation of each strip (± 1 ha) as mining progress. The MR Holder proposed the following with regard to rehabilitation of the mined-out strips:

- The mining plan will be such that topsoil is stockpiled for the minimum possible time through rehabilitating different mining blocks progressively as mining continues.
- To ensure minimum impact on drainage, the MR Holder will take care not to leave any depressions in the mining floor. A surface slope (even if minimal) will be maintained across the mining floor in the drainage direction, so that all excavations are free draining.
- After mining, any steep slopes at the edges of excavations will be reduced to a minimum and profiled to blend with the surrounding topography.
- The stockpiled topsoil will then be evenly spread over the entire mining area, so that there is a depth of 300 mm of sandy topsoil.
- The MR Holder will strive to (when possible) spread topsoil at a time of the year when vegetation cover can be established as quickly as possible afterwards, so that erosion of returned topsoil by both rain and wind, is minimized.

- A cover crop will be planted and established immediately after spreading of topsoil to stabilize the soil and protect it from erosion.
- The rehabilitated area will monthly be monitored for erosion, and appropriately stabilized if any erosion occurs.
- The MR Holder will ensure monthly monitoring of weeds/invaser plants that may germinated within the rehabilitated areas.

APPLICATION FOR CLOSURE

Once the full mining area was rehabilitated the MR Holder will submit a closure application to the Department of Mineral Resources in accordance with section 43(4) of the MPRDA, 2002 that states: *“An application for a closure certificate must be made to the Regional Manager in whose region the land in question is situated within 180 days of the occurrence of the lapsing, abandonment, cancellation, cessation, relinquishment or completion contemplated in subsection (3) and must be accompanied by the prescribed environmental risk report”*.

The Closure Application will be submitted in terms of Regulation 62 of the MPRDA, 2002, and Government Notice 940 of NEMA, 1998.

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT

Department provided that the party provide its name, contact details and address and discloses any direct business, financial, personal or other interest which he/she may have in the approval or refusal of the applications.

The Draft Scoping Report (DSR) will be submitted to the Department of Mineral Resources – Western Cape (DMR) for review purposes. This report will also be made available to the public for a 30 days review period. An electronic copy of the report will be published on the Greenmined Environmental website (www.greenmined.com). All registered I&AP's and stakeholders will be notified of the commenting period in advance as above.

The DSR will then be updated to reflect the comments received during the public commenting period. Thereafter, the Final Scoping Report (FSR) will be submitted to DMR for its consideration as part of the authorization process in terms of the NEMA, 2014 regulations (as amended 2017). A copy of the FSR will be made available on the Greenmined Environmental website. Once the Final Scoping Report has been accepted by the DMR, the Draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report (DEIAR) will be prepared, inclusive of the specialist studies (if applicable), and also made available to the public for a 30-day commenting period. An electronic copy of the DEIAR report will also be published on the Greenmined Environmental website. All registered I&AP's and stakeholders will be notified of the commenting period in advance.

Upon expiry of the commenting period the DEIAR will be updated to reflect the comments received during the public commenting period. Thereafter, the Final EIAR will be submitted to the DMR for its consideration as part of the authorization process in terms of the NEMA 2014 regulations (as amended by GNR 326 effective 07 April 2017). A copy of the final report will be made available on the Greenmined Environmental website. All registered I&AP's and stakeholders will be notified in writing within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the decision of the outcome of the application, including the reasons for the decision and the right of appeal.





COMMENTS: NOTICE OF APPLICATION IN TERMS OF SECTION 102 OF THE MINERALS AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2002 (ACT NO 28 OF 2002) AND THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT 107 OF 1998) AS WELL AS THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS, 2014 (AS AMENDED 2017) IN PORTION 4 OF FARM ZANDFONTEIN NO 97, ROBERTSON.

The Breede-Gouritz Catchment Management Agency (BGCMA) has received the Notice of Application as indicated above on 30 January 2020.

BGCMA has no objections to the proposed development. However, the following is noted:

- a) There's little to no stockpiling is required and no washing of sand is needed which means that the sand mining operation will not require the use of water; and
- b) The mining footprint will extend over an area classified as a phase 2 FEPA (Freshwater Priority Area) according to the National Wetlands and NFEPA map of SANBI. Therefore, the conservation status of the area will be assessed and discussed during the EIA process of this application.

Therefore, through acknowledgement of watercourses (drainage lines) in the area earmarked for sand mining expansion, impacts on the watercourses should be evaluated in the EIA process as they will assist in the type of Water Use Authorisation triggered by the proposed sand mining activities. BGCMA would therefore, make final comments when the impacts on the watercourses (drainage lines) have been properly evaluated under the EIA process.

General

- No water must be taken from a water resource for any purpose without authorisation from the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998).
- No waste or water containing waste may be disposed without authorisation from the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998) and National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act 59 of 2008).
- No unauthorised activities should take place within a regulated area of a watercourse.
- All relevant sections and regulations of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998) regarding water use must be adhered to.
- No pollution of surface water or groundwater resources may occur.
- Stormwater management must be addressed in terms of flooding, erosion and pollution potential.
- No stormwater runoff from any premises containing waste, or water containing waste emanating from industrial activities and premises may be discharged into a water resource. Polluted stormwater must be contained.

Please be advised that no activities may commence without the appropriate approvals/authorizations where needed from the responsible authority. The onus remains with the registered property owner to confirm adherence to any relevant legislation that such activities might trigger and/or need authorisation for.

This office reserves the right to amend and revise its comments as well as to request any further information.

Die paartjie het ook glo nog nie gesê hoe hulle, noudat hulle nie meer deur die familie onderhou gaan word nie, 'n inkomste gaan verdien nie. Ek dink dis een van die redes hoekom Meghan se pa omgekrap is.

'n Video wat wys waar prins Harry met die grootbaas van Disney by die Britse première van die nuwe Lion King-fliëk gesels, het onlangs die lig gesien en mense glo prins Harry het geskimp vir werk vir Meghan.

Die klank op die video is 'n bietjie sag en 'n mens kan nie regtig hoor waaroor hulle praat nie.

Ek kon eintlik nie fokus op hul gesprek nie, want my aandag was by Meghan, Beyonce en Jay Z met sy lelike hare wat soos Beyonce se lyfwag lyk. Dis ook maar goed hy het nie Simba in die Lion King gespeel nie.

As prins Harry se voorlegging oortuigend genoeg was en Disney hou van Meghan, sal ons dalk in die nuwe jaar 'n nuwe Disney-prinses hê – Meghan het immers nou die ondervinding.
