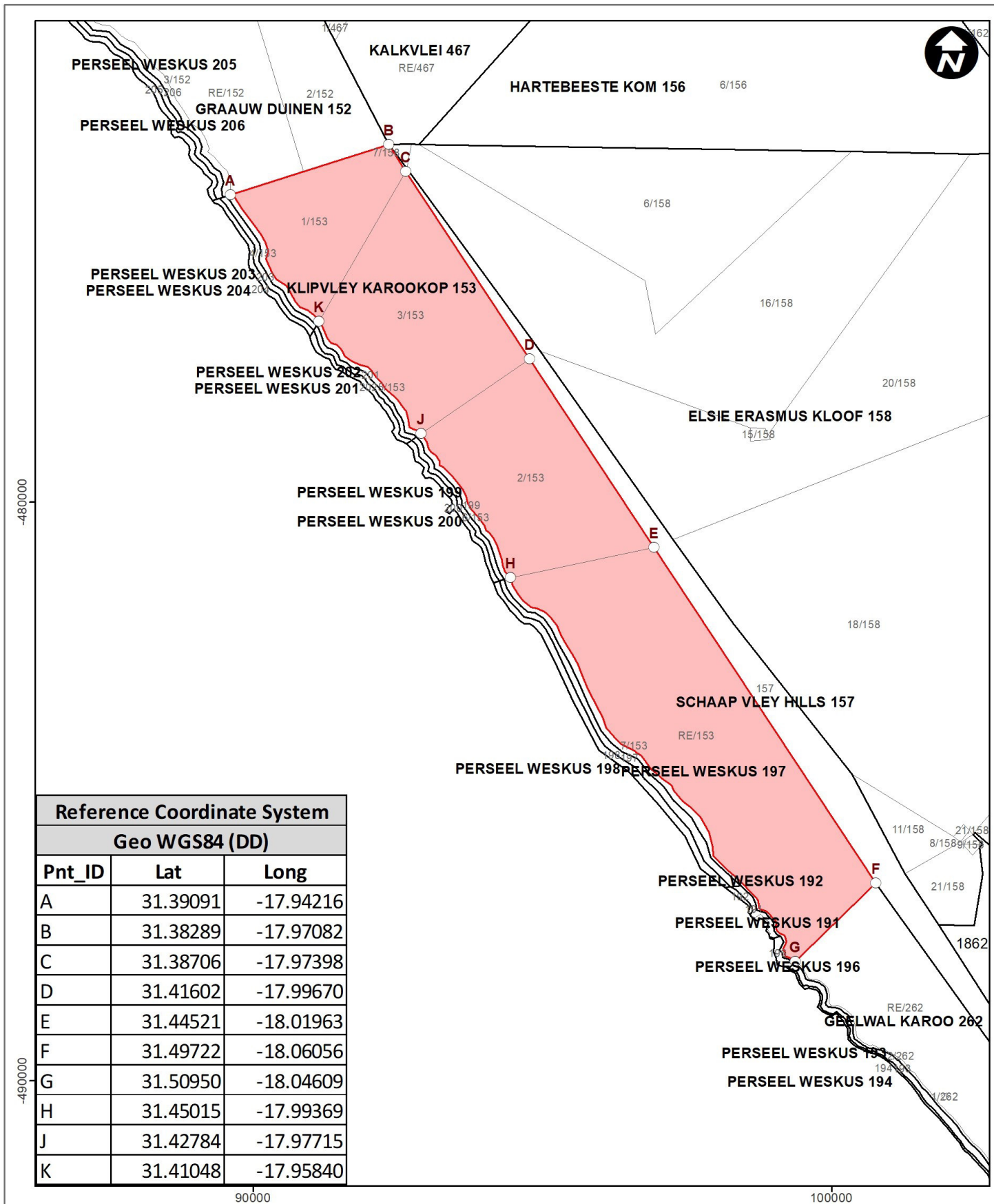

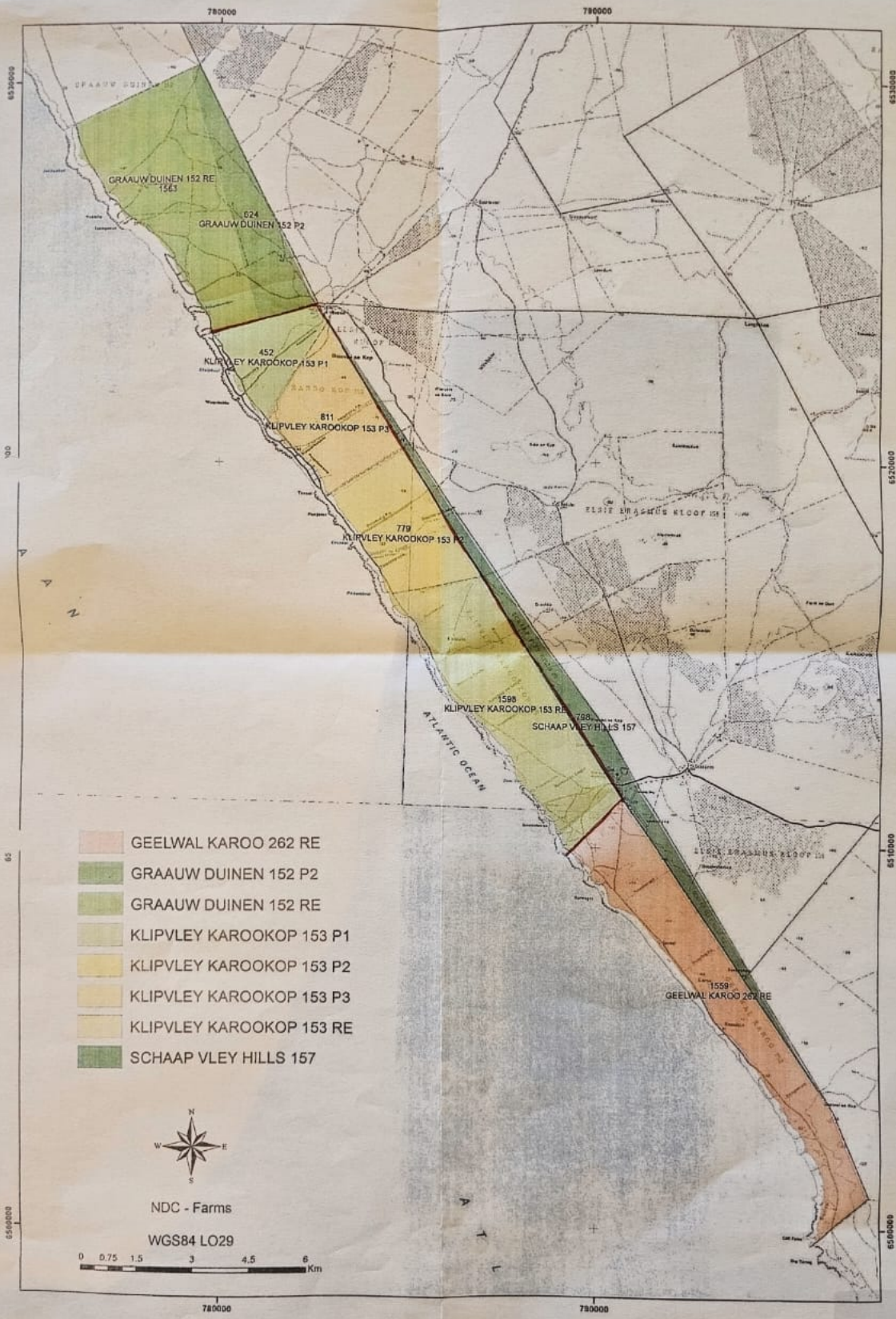

Context and purpose	MSR’s application for Prospecting Rights. The meeting served to clarify with the land owners of northern beaches 1-10: – The intended prospecting location/area. – Scope of works. – General questions/concerns
Discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• (SM) explained the purpose of the meeting, in that MSR seeks to clarify the identified locations for prospecting and explained that this project is a part of the mine’s future growth strategy.• Further (SM) noted that the DMRE was consulted, the application process has commenced and baseline studies are underway.• (SM) distributed a map (please see attached), to attendees showing the exact prospecting location.• (JA) asked on which side of the road prospecting will start from. (SM) explained that MSR has no interest in the portion of area from the farm boundary to the road and ecological studies shows that a buffer of 10 meters must be maintained.• (BV) asked if the proclaimed road will be closed. (SM) replied that for now prospecting still needs to be executed in order to get a better understanding of availability and quality of minerals, but the mine seek to control access only for now.



- (JA) conveyed a concern of the traffic that will commute the proclaimed road and the area in general, and asked if a prospecting service provider has been appointed as yet. (TH) responded that the process will go out on tender. In response to the question regarding depth of drilling (TH) answered that drilling will go to a depth of 120 m.
- (CA) enquired about the planned turnaround time? (SM) responded that it should take another 6 months for the prospecting application and that all land owners will be notified as soon as prospecting rights are granted.
- In response to which other minerals will MSR search for (SM) responded besides the usual minerals the mine extract, the intention was also to search for diamonds.
- The Visser’s made known their general discontent with regards to the Moonstone tailings on certain parts of the northern beaches and mentioned that they requested from Moonstone, via their lawyer, a rehabilitation documents to be made available for their perusal.
- In response to how large the intended footprint size will be, (TH) responded approximately 200 X 12Km’s (3035 hectares) times two portions.
- (BV) commented that Mainstream is willing to offer R120 000 per year for 1 turbine, and that green energy is override existing means of energy generation.
- Landowners noted that they need to give an answer to Mainstream soonest.
- (SM) reiterated that this is new information, therefore MSR will need to inform their executives and arrange another meeting with the landowners to reconvene in a few weeks’ time.
- (SM) noted that the mine hope to secure, for the use of mining purposes, the strandline from the northern beaches through to the Olifants river estuary. MSR is also looking at constructing a MSP plant, commencing in the next year.
- (SM) once again apologised for land access payments being delayed earlier in 2023, and explained that cash flow was directed more on larger projects which are under way, the availability of cash flow however is in the process of changing as there is a noticeable turnaround on the company’s balance sheet currently.
- (BV) asked if the bright high mast spotlight at MSR’s main gate can be tilted to cast away from their farm/beach house. MSR delegates agreed to look into the request.
- (SM) expressed his appreciation for the relationship between MSR and its neighbours.
